

Special provisions in divergence from the General Terms and Conditions for Participation in Exhibitions (hereinafter referred to as the 'Exhibitor Regulations')

16.2 Downpayment

Further to Clause 16.2 of the Exhibitor Regulations (last updated: September 2023), MCH is authorised to request advance payment for it to provide additional services that are not already covered by the net charge for the exhibition space or for the exhibitor package and may make the provision of the service dependent on such an advance payment.

MCH may request advance payment for each additional service, for a range of different services, or for a combination of the two. The advance payment may be payable as a lump sum or as a percentage of the net charge for the required additional services.

MCH may require that the advance payment be settled together with the downpayment invoice or separately from it. MCH may also request that several advance payments be made. The advance payment(s) made will be deducted from the final sum due.

9 Catering

In divergence from Clause 9 of the Exhibitor Regulations (last updated: September 2023), during the opening hours of the exhibition, exhibitors or companies employed by them are permitted to serve food and drinks free of charge to visitors at their booth, providing these are intended to be consumed in situ (e.g., as part of tastings, occasional catering, food stands, or event catering). No alcohol may be served to children and young people under the age of 16. Distilled alcoholic drinks may not be served to children and young people under the age of 18. Ceteris paribus, exhibitors are required to comply with any and all applicable legal provisions.
